2 External auditor report 2017/18

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The smaller authority has amended the 2016/17 figures based on information provided by the previous external auditor in relation to receipts of £24,691 in 2016/17. Information provided to us by the smaller authority indicates that Box 3 of 2016/17 and Box 6 of 2017/18 (and consequently Box 7 of 2016/17 and Box 1 of 2017/18) have been understated by £24,691. The correct figures are shown below with the amended figures in bold type. Please ensure the 2017/18 figures are restated when completing the comparatives for the 2018/19 AGAR.
