Active Mid Devon is teaming up with Libraries Unlimited to support the community's health and wellbeing with free drop-in events at Crediton and Cullompton libraries this May.

The sessions will take place on Friday 8 May at Crediton Library and Thursday 14 May at Cullompton Library, running from 10am to 2pm. During the events, the Active Mid Devon team will offer free checks including blood pressure monitoring to help assess heart and artery health, as well as cholesterol testing to indicate the risk of heart disease and whether small lifestyle changes could make a difference.
